The Human Rights Department, Government of Sindh has organized a one-day seminar on "Promoting Rule of Law, Access to Justice and Accountability" at Mirpurkhas. The event brought together senior government officials, law enforcement representatives, human rights activists from across the province, and Special Assistant to the Chief Minister for Human Rights, attended as Chief Guest along with Shabbir A.K. Chaudhary, Human Rights Department. In his welcome address, Director Human Rights emphasized the Department's commitment to strengthening justice and equality through collaborative practices between the government, civil society, and law enforcement agencies. He stated that access to justice is not only a constitutional guarantee but also a moral responsibility of every institution in Sindh. Shabbir A.K. Chaudhary, Secretary Human Rights Department, in his introductory remarks, outlined the key objectives of the seminar, including awareness on constitutional rights, complaint redressal mechanisms, and inter-departmental cooperation for upholding the rule of law. In his closing presentation on "Minority Rights and Access to Justice", he emphasized the Department's commitment to ensuring equal access to justice for all citizens, regardless of their background.

Program. Highlighted challenges faced by minority communities in accessing justice, particularly for women and children. He noted that minorities constitute nearly 9% of the population in the province. Division with persistent gaps in legal awareness, representation, and timely justice delivery. He called for strengthened institutional coordination, support at the grassroots level, and inclusion of minority groups in governance mechanisms. Speaking on "Strengthening Legal Safeguards and Citizens' Rights", legal expert support underscored that Articles 4, 8-28, and 25-A of the Constitution of Pakistan provide fundamental protection to citizens, but effective implementation requires active monitoring and accountability at the local level. The discussion stressed the need for stronger institutional linkages between the police, judiciary, and human rights bodies for timely grievance redressal. On the topic of "Women's Rights to Justice: Challenges in Addressing Gender-Based Violence", Shabbir A.K. Chaudhary presented data showing that Sindh continues to face a high number of gender-based violence cases, with over 1,200 reported annually. He noted that Mirpurkhas Division alone accounts for nearly 8% of the total. He highlighted cultural barriers, lack of legal aid, and insufficient support for victims as major challenges, urging greater collaboration between Human Rights

Department, Women's Representative, the law enforcement agencies, and civil society. He emphasized that all complaints received through the Department would be properly investigated and addressed. Dr. Shabbir A.K. Chaudhary also welcomed the establishment of a Human Rights Resource Centre at Mirpurkhas and a Human Rights Resource Centre at Mirpurkhas. He stressed the importance of community-based approaches in addressing human rights issues. Additional comments were made by the Department's officers, who stressed the role of law and human rights in the development of the province. Support from the divisional administration is crucial for coordination and response to human rights issues. Shabbir A.K. Chaudhary continued work in promoting access to justice and the rule of law across Sindh, emphasizing that justice depends on collective institutional will and citizen participation.
